





YATE RIDE & LION'S SEA

Excursion starts from the local port towards Alice Island, where it will be possible to observe a colony of sea lions of a hair. Then we will sail to the Bird Island, habitat of colonies of royal and imperial cormorants and their nests. Later we will sail to a small island where there are sea lions of two hairs. Nearby is the Lighthouse Les Eclaireurs (Lighthouse of the End of the World), which is the symbol of the city of Ushuaia and was built in 1919. From there it is possible to see the island of rock cormorants. Returning, we will disembark at Bridges Island. There we will travel a path of interpretation of flora and avifauna. The guides will tell the story of the aboriginal Yamanas. From this island we can observe the magnificence of the Beagle Channel and, in the distance, The city of Ushuaia. During the sailing we will share coffee with liquor, different varieties of tea, hot chocolate with sweet cookies and, of course, the typical Argentine mate.
