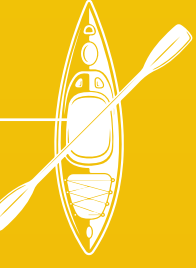




ISLA DE LOS FUEGOS



WALK WITH PINGUINS

We start early in the morning, meeting at the tourist pier. We begin the bus tour to National Route 3 and Provincial Route J, where you can appreciate the beautiful Fuegian forest.

Once we reach the coast of the Beagle Channel, we will take a zodiac boat for approximately 20 minutes to Martillo Island, where we will walk alongside Magellanic and Gentoo penguins for an hour, always with a guide, enjoying a unique adventure! The penguins settle on the island during the summer, sharing the habitat with other birds. Martillo Island, in the Beagle Channel, is part of Estancia Harberton and is home to the penguins.

Upon returning to the estancia, we will visit the bird and mammal museum. On our return to the city of Ushuaia via Route J, we will make one last stop to see the flag tree. An icon of the place, it has taken this shape due to the action of the wind.
